Financial support:

TIET provides financial aid of merit scholarship for the students who have scored above 160 cutoffs in their higher secondary examination, For those deserving students who miss out in the Top 5 are also given fee waiver in tuition fees. Free bus facilities for girl students and 50% bus fees concession for boy students. Also provide a free hostel facility for poor students. This scholarship is entitled not only for First Graduate students but also for worthy non First Graduate students.




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Activities for slow learners:

- iii) Giving counseling for slow learners.
- iv) Group study methodology.
- iv) Giving additional learning materials like question bank, university question papers etc.
